

2018 April Membership Meeting Saturday, April 28, 2018, 10 a.m. Summit County Architectural Heritage Awards Ceremony

Our regularly scheduled April meeting will celebrate the 2018 Architectural Heritage Award recipients. The awards, presented biennially as a joint project of Progress Through Preservation of Greater Akron (PTP) and the Summit County Historical Society of Akron, Ohio (SCHS), recognize projects, individuals, and organizations that celebrate and enhance the architectural importance and historic character of Akron and Greater Summit County. The 2018 award winners represent a variety of award categories and include: The Wine Mill in Peninsula, the Akron Soap Factory and the Cascade Lofts, both in downtown Akron, the Seiberling Homestead in Norton, the Scissor Room in Munroe Falls, and Allan Sveda of Hudson.

We will meet for brunch at 10 a.m. on Saturday, April 28, at the Trailhead Event Space located at 21 West North St. The event center is located on the first floor of the Cascade Lofts building, which is one of our award winners. The lofts are built on the site of the 1885 Schumacher Milling Company. That building was purchased in 1905 and enlarged for Swinehart Tire & Rubber. The current structure was built in 1914 and is situated along the canal towpath at Lock 15, part of the Cascade Locks Historic District. A pedestrian bridge at the end of the parking lot leads over the canal to the nearby Mustill Store and House.

Reservations: We will have a delicious brunch provided by Vaccaro's Catering followed by the presentation of the awards. After the awards ceremony, guests may tour portions of the Cascade Lofts building. Directions & Parking: From the corner of Main and Market streets in downtown Akron, go north on Main (which becomes Howard Street when you pass MLK Jr. boulevard/Perkins street); immediately after the North street intersection (second light), turn left into the driveway for the Cascade Lofts parking lot.
